



## KLTP-Heavy Construction Labourer

1. Entry level Heavy construction Labour \$20.50/hr.  
\*0-1 years of relevant work experience.
2. Intermediate Heavy construction Labour \$23.25/hr.  
\* Must have a Construction Craft Worker certificate **or** 1-3 years' relevant work experience.
3. Skilled Heavy construction Labour \$26.60/hr.  
\*Must have a Construction Craft Worker certificate **or** 3-5 years' of relevant work experience.
4. Senior Heavy construction Labour \$31.30/hr.  
\*Must have Construction Craft Worker certificate with a minimum of 2 years' of relevant Experience **or** no certificate with a minimum of 5+ years' relevant experience.

### Position Requirements:

- Labourers must have physical strength, stamina and use proper lifting techniques to manage heavy materials as well as be able to stand for long periods. They must have manual dexterity, mechanical aptitude, the ability to follow instructions, and the ability to work safe in extreme weather conditions.
- Labourers must have steel-toed boots, rain gear, appropriate work clothes.
- Able to pass a Drug & Alcohol test as well as a fit for work test

### Working Conditions:

Heavy Construction labourers assist all tradespersons and perform labouring activities at construction sites. Working as a construction worker is physically strenuous work since workers carry heavy loads and often contort their bodies to access difficult to reach areas. Many work on roofs or other elevated platforms and often work in inclement weather. To prevent bodily harm, construction laborers must wear protective equipment. Workers must be extremely cautious, and follow all safety rules, when working on underground construction projects. Safety equipment will be provided, such as hard hat, safety vest, gloves, and safety glasses. Specialized safety equipment will be provided as well (fall protection, masks, etc.)

### Responsibilities:

- Load and unload construction materials, and move materials to work areas
- Erect and dismantle concrete forms, scaffolding, ramps, catwalks, shoring and barricades required at construction sites
- Mix, pour and spread materials such as concrete and asphalt
- Assist tradespersons such as carpenters, cement finishers, in construction activities
- Assist heavy equipment operators to secure special attachments to equipment, signal operators to guide them in moving equipment and provide assistance in other activities
- Assist in aligning pipes and perform related activities during oil and gas pipeline construction
- Assist in drilling and blasting rock at construction sites
- Assist miners in excavating and in setting up and operating various drills and other surface mining machinery
- Level earth to fine grade specifications using rake and shovel
- Assist in demolishing buildings using prying bars and other tools, and sort, clean and pile salvaged materials
- Remove rubble and other debris at construction sites using rakes, shovels, wheelbarrows and other equipment
- Operate pneumatic hammers, vibrators and tampers as directed
- Maintain and operate machines or equipment used in construction such as mixers, compressors and pumps
- Oil and grease hoists and similar equipment
- Direct machines on construction sites
- Perform other activities at construction sites, as directed.
- Physical strength and stamina Manual dexterity
- Able to pass for Drug & Alcohol testing as well as fitness for work testing
- the ability to use proper lifting techniques to lift items weighing up to 50 lbs.,
- A safety conscious attitude, and the ability to work with others in a team.
